#### Watermelon and Charred Tomato Salad

#### **Ingredients**

- 4 plum tomatoes, halved lengthwise
- Extra-virgin olive oil, for brushing
- 2 pounds seedless watermelon rind removed, flesh cut into 1/2-inch dice



- 1 English cucumber halved, seeded and cut into 1/2-inch dice
- · 3 tablespoons fresh lime juice
- 1/2 teaspoon crushed red pepper
- 1/2 cup chopped cilantro
- Kosher salt

#### **Directions**

- Light a grill or preheat a grill pan; oil the grill grate.
- Brush the tomatoes with olive oil and grill cut side down over high heat until charred, about 4 minutes.
- Transfer to a plate and let cool completely. Cut the tomatoes into 1/2-inch dice.
- In a large bowl, toss the tomatoes with the watermelon, cucumber, lime juice and crushed red pepper.
- Stir in the cilantro, season with salt and serve at once.

Buyers' preferences are constantly evolving, and sellers can benefit from minor adjustments that appeal to buyers and help to optimize their sales price and reduce the time on the market. Design trends include:

- Sustainable features such as water-efficient appliances and fixtures, the use of recycled materials, systems for harvesting rainwater, solar panels, and LED lighting. Green features. Sleek kitchen designs with clean lines and neutral colors.
- Simple patterns. Mosaic backsplashes and countertops with busy patterns are not as popular as they were. Today's buyers are drawn to simplicity such as white subway tiles, quartz countertops, and white cabinets.
- 3. **Permeability between the indoors and outdoors.** Homeowners are increasingly seeking to bring the

- outdoors in and the indoors out. Consider full outdoor kitchens and patio heating and cooling systems, including fire pits, heat lamps, and misters.
- 4. **Copper accents.** Usually found in sinks, faucets, and doorknobs, these features provide a richer alternative to the stainless steel that has been popular in the past.
- 5. **Calming colors**. Typically, the international color authority Pantone names only one "color of the year." In 2016, however, its experts bestowed that title on both Rose Quartz and Serenity, the latter of which is described as a cool blue.
- 6. **Incorporation of craftsmanship** into modern design such as aged wood to soften the sterility of otherwise modern rooms and create an appealing contrast of styles.
- Spa-like master bathrooms. Many homeowners are expressing an interest in master baths that serve as athome retreats.
